BREEDS & ELIGIBILITY

ELIGIBLE BREEDS & REGISTRY:

Only purebred Afghan Hounds, Azawakhs, Basenjis, Borzoi, Cimeco dell'Etna, Greyhounds, Ibizan Hounds, Irish Wolfhounds, Italian Greyhounds, Pharaoh Hounds, Rhodesian Ridgebacks, Salukis, Scottish Deerhounds, Sloughis, Whippets, and provisional Breeds may be entered in the regular stakes. Current Provisional breed: Silken Windhound. Limited breeds may be entered in the Limited Stake or the Singles Stake. Limited breeds currently include purebred CP Chart Polski, GE Galgo Espanol, MA Magyar Agar, PI Peruvian Inca Orchid, PQ Portuguese Podengo (Pequeno). PP Portuguese Podengo (Mendio & Grande), and must be individually registered with the appropriate registry. All entries shall be individually registered with the AKC (including ILP & PAL), the NGA, the UKC, the FCI, an ASFA – recognized foreign or ASFA Board approved registry, or possess a CRN from the SPDBS.

REGULAR STAKE OFFERED:

OPEN – Any eligible sight hound that has met certification requirements excluding ASFA Field Champions of record.

FIELD CHAMPION – Any ASFA Field Champion.

VETERAN – Any eligible sight hound that has met qualification requirements and whose age is at least 6 years, except Irish Wolfhounds whose age shall be at least 5 years. Afghans, Rhodesian Ridgebacks and Whippets whose age shall be at least 7 years.

LIMITED STAKES – Any eligible sight hound of a Limited Stake breed that has met the certification requirements. The winner of this stake is not eligible to compete in Best of Breed and/or Best in Event.

SINGLE STAKE – Any eligible sight hound including those disqualified to run in other stakes. Not eligible of Best of Breed or Best in Event. Hounds are eligible to earn TCP and CPX titles from the Singles stake. Limited breeds are not eligible for these titles.

NON-REGULAR STAKES OFFERED:

BENCH STAKE: For any; sight hound with proof on file with the ASFA of a conformation champion title from the AKC, CKC or both or a conformation grand champion title from the UKC. To enter this stake, the owner must attach a copy of the hound's show championship certificate to the entry form.

BREEDER STAKE: For any breed which shall have, designated at time of entry, two hounds bred by the same individual

KENNEL STAKE: For hounds of any individual breeds; an entry shall consist of two hounds designated at time of entry, in one of the regular stakes being owned and kenneled by the same person.

NEW REGIONAL INVITATIONAL REQUIREMENTS

Any hound that has earned at least 1 ASFA point is eligible to enter. For a Limited Stake or Provisional breed to be eligible, the entered hound must have received a placement, with competition. All points or placements must be earned by the closing date of the event. Any hound entered in the Single Stake does not need prior ASFA experience. An eligible hound may be entered in any number of Regional Invitationals.

BEST IN EVENT—SUNDAY ONLY:

This competition is run on Sunday, following the same procedures as Best in Event, except that all best of Breed winners from Saturday and Sunday; are eligible to compete provided they have been entered and received qualifying scores both Saturday and Sunday. The hound that wins Best in Event will be credited with winning a Best in Event.

Directions to our Lure Field Trial

From the North/West: I64 east to exit 234, Rte. 199 east towards Lightfoot. Exit Rte. 199 at Monticello Ave. and bear right onto Rte. 321/Rte. 5000 west. Proceed straight for approx. 7 miles. Monticello Ave or Rte. 5000 will turn into John Tyler Hwy or Rte. 5. The park will be the last driveway on the right hand side of Rte. 5 before the Chickahominy River Bridge.

From the East: I-64 west to exit 242 towards Jamestown. Rte. 199 west. At Monticello Ave exit bear left and continue with *From the North/West directions.*

From the South: Take Rte. 31 north to the Jamestown Ferry. After crossing the river continue on Rte. 31 to Rte. 614 (first left after the Jamestown Beach Campsites). Stay on Rte. 614 to Rte. 5, make a left onto Rte. 5 and proceed to the Chickahominy Riverfront Park on right.

From the West: Take Rte. 5 east from I-295. Take a left after crossing the Chickahominy River Bridge into the park.

Field and Equipment Information:

--Type of Machine: A battery-powered, continuous—loop machine will be used. Back-up equipment will be available. The lure will consist of highly – visible white plastic bags. The course will be reversed for finals, run-off, Best of Breed, and again for Best in Event. The field is mown grass and basically level.

-- SHOT reserves the right to alter the course plan as required by weather and/or field conditions.

Only the Lure Operator, Huntmaster, Judges and handlers of the hunds running in the course in progress will be permitted near the lure machine.

Conditions of Entry:

-All entries must be one year or older on the day of the trial and have at least one ASFA point.

-Stakes will be split into flights by public random draw if the entry in any regular stake is 20 or more

-Bitches in season, lame hounds and hounds with breed disqualifications will be excused at roll call

-Spayed, neutered, monorchid or cryptorchid hounds without breed disqualifications may be entered.

-Hounds with breed disqualifications are not eligible to enter except in the Single Stakes

-Hounds not present at the time of roll call will be scratched

-All hounds will run twice, in trios if possible or braces (except in the Single Stake), unless excused, dismissed or disqualified.

--Substitute entries will be allowed for lame or in-season hounds up until day-of-trial closing

NOTE:

--An enforced \$5.00 fine will be imposed for any loose hound not competing in a course in progress.

--Any person may, upon reasonable complaint, be asked to leave the grounds of the field trial by the Field Committee and may be disciplined by the ASFA.

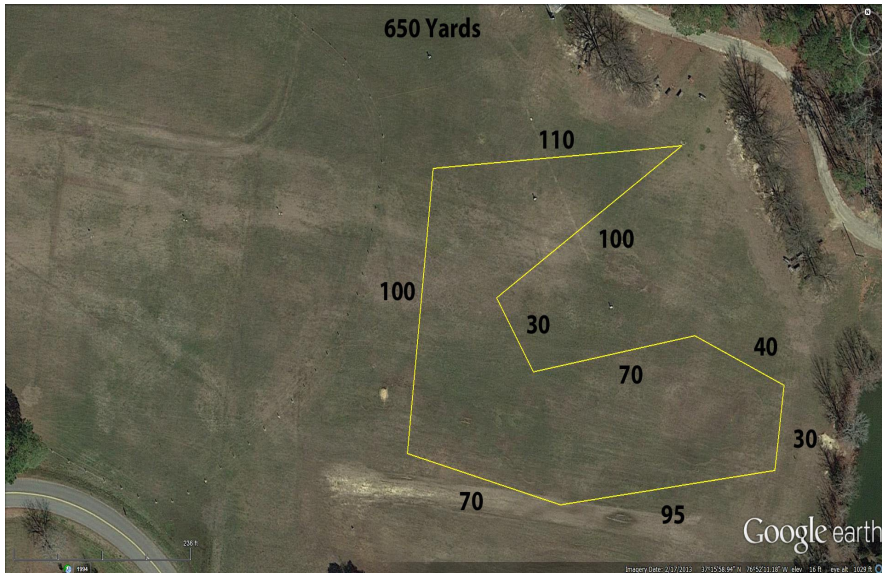
